An approval will be issued upon completion of a site assessment of this application 			

- I understand that this application will not be granted if the intended clearing is in an environmentally sensitive area
- I am responsible for ensuring the fence is constructed along the property boundary
- I am responsible for locating all public utilities by completing a Dial Before You Dig service
- I am responsible for all costs associated with clearing
- I will maintain a safe worksite at all times during clearing activities and the construction of the fence
- I will leave the verge in a condition that is no worse than prior to clearing
- I will be required to submit a traffic management plan to the Shire for approval where it is necessary for plant or machinery to operate on the roadside of the verge to carry out the proposed works.
