Disaster Ready Fund Success

The Shire of Boyup Brook is excited to announce that we have been successful in our application to upgrade our sporting clubrooms to enable their use as a Community Evacuation Centre in the case of an emergency.



In Disaster Ready Fund (DRF) round one National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) received over 300 applications nationally. All eligible applications were assessed via a robust and transparent process managed by the NEMA in accordance with the published program Guidelines. Project Update



Drainage and structural renovations are well underway at the Town Hall and looking on track for completion by the end of August. The Lesser Hall flooring is currently in the process of being replaced along with work to the front of the hall. The exterior public toilets have remained open to the public, please ensure you continue to follow all signage when using the carpark or public toilets. No entry is permitted to the construction site.

The Cemetery project has also begun with initial ground stability and geotechnical testing completed. Phase 2 will see the Shire appoint drainage engineers to provide recommendations.

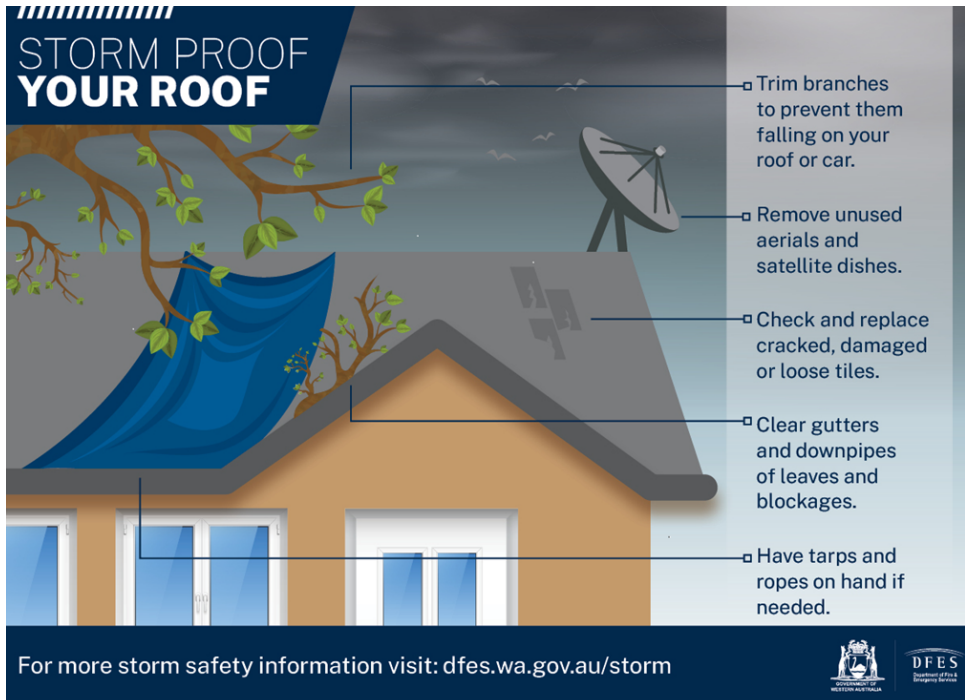

As storms can happen at any time and sometimes without much notice, it is best to prepare and maintain your property throughout the year.

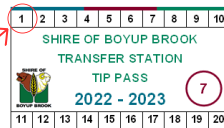
