

3. PUBLIC QUESTIONS TIME

Questions from Sue White

1. What is the correct number of residents in the Shire? The Annual Report refers to 1,834 on page 3 whereas the population on page 9 refers to 1,702.

Response from CEO:

We will look at the statistics and correct the Annual Report.

2. What is happening to the pool, it is terrible and the algae will damage the paint.

Response from CEO:

The Pool Manager visits the pool regularly, to save cost during the closed season the minimal amount of chemicals are used. When the pool season starts, the pool will be in a pristine condition.

3. Any indication of when the pool will open? And hopefully the pool won't close until after the April school holidays.

Response from CEO

The pool will open as in previous years in October, we will try stay open as long as possible but is dependent on weather and use of the pool.

4. I have been told there is a new pump sitting there.

Response from CEO:

Not aware of there being a new pump already onsite. The pump required for the heating system has been ordered.

5. Where is the new pump to come from?

Response from CEO:

The pump will be sourced from Bunbury.

6. The Shire has promised to get the heating of the pool addressed for a longer season.

Response from CEO:

Before the pump is installed into the Blackwood River, the Shire is required to obtain Aboriginal Heritage approval. A meeting has been arranged with the Wagyl Kiap Aboriginal Corporation.

7. Do you have a figure what it would cost to replace the whole system?

Response from CEO:

The Shire is currently investigating alternative methods to heat the pool but have not got any costings at this stage.
